Class Objectives: Students will be able to understand the effects of climate change and reflect on their contributions and potential solutions to the problems

- I. Course Goals: This lesson will address Learning outcomes 1,4,5,7,8,10. In addition, this lesson will enable students to write reflectively about their lives.
- II. Anticipatory Set: Student will watch the one hour BBC film- David Attenborough: The Truth about Climate Change (BBC - Part 2)

- III. A 30 minute class discussion will follow the video.
- IV. For homework, students will take the environmental footprint survey at <http://myfootprint.org/subscription.php>
- V. In this class session, students will compare the results from the footprint survey.
- VI. In small groups, students will look at their homes and daily lives to identify three ways in which they can reduce their environmental footprints.
- VII. Concluding Session: Students will write a five- paragraph descriptive essay on what the world would look like for their grandchildren if the status quo remains; they will cite current research to support their claims.
